

Mitten Project

Are you traveling to exotic places this year? Bring a skein of local fiber back to the lodge for our mitten project. We are knitting mittens from wool from around the world. So far we have Icelandic sheep, Tunis sheep, and wool from Greece and Turkey in our collection. Look for wool or other natural fibers that come from specific breeds; "black welsh mountain sheep" or "Gotland wool". If it says "100% pure new wool" it could be anything. Each mitten is labeled with its country of origin, the type of wool, and a picture of the type of sheep it came from. We would really like some Qiviut from Alaska. That comes from muskox!
