Jarlsberg Filled Peppers (Jarlsbergfylt paprika)

Authentic Norwegian Cooking
by Astrid Karlsen Scott

- 4 large peppers, red or green
- 2 tsp. coarse salt
- 1 lb. (450g) ground meat, low fat
- ½ tsp. Tabasco®
- ½ tsp. pepper, coarsely ground
- ½ tsp. garlic salt

cup (½ dl) French bread crumbs

- juice from 1 lemon
- 1¼ cup (3 dl) Jarlsberg®, diced
- 3½ tbsp. butter
- garlic salt

Divide peppers in two, remove stem and seeds. Sprinkle the coarse salt on baking pan. Mix meat, Tabasco, garlic salt, pepper, lemon juice, crumbs and half of Jarlsberg cheese. Divide evenly between the peppers. Top the peppers with remainder of the cheese. Melt butter, add garlic salt and brush over the peppers. Place on top of coarse salt on baking sheet, and bake in 350°F (175°C) oven for about 35 minutes. Serves 4-6.
