I wish all of you a safe and fun summer.

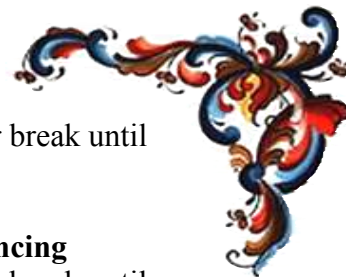
